

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION & SAFETY CODE

It is our wish that you have a safe and enjoyable weekend with us at Goodrich Park. Please work with us to achieve this by observing the following Safety Code:

Gates to the Vintage Rally & Country Fair will be open for exhibitors and trade stands at 2.30pm on Thursday 15th June 2017. There will be no exceptions to this without prior arrangement with the organisers. All exhibitors must leave the site by 10.30 on the 19th June.

Exhibitor and camping/caravanning passes must be displayed on the appropriate vehicle windscreen at all times. A pass is only valid if the registration number of the vehicle is written on it. Only two entrance tickets will be issued per exhibit/trader unless by prior arrangement.

5mph is the speed limit for all vehicles on the site and roadways. This must be strictly adhered to. The event will be open to the public from 10am-6pm on Saturday and from 10am-5pm Sunday. For safety reasons, vehicle movements on site between these times will be restricted and must be authorised.

We request that any exhibitor entering the show shall be on site for the duration in which the show is open to the public.

Campers/Caravanners. In the unlikely event of fire, it is essential that we can quickly remove a caravan from a line of other vehicles. Help us to help you, by ensuring that all caravan drawbars are facing the same direction.

Tractor exhibitors. Please note that only one person (the driver) will be authorised to ride on a tractor. Passengers are prohibited.

You as the exhibitor are responsible for all members of the group of people that accompany you.

You must ensure that you and they are competent and capable to undertake their part in any displays you / they are involved with. Drivers of vehicles must be licensed and insured for the vehicle they are driving.

Please ensure that safety ropes and fences remain in place and that unauthorised persons do not enter enclosures.

Any driver suspected of drinking whilst operating a moving vehicle will be asked to leave the site.

Please help us to keep the site clean by placing all rubbish in the bins and skips provided. Do not tip caravan waste down the portable toilets.

Our Stewards and Safety Officers will be working to protect everyone on site. **Any exhibitor ignoring a request from a Steward or Safety Officer will be asked to leave the site immediately.**

The organisers cannot accept any claim for damage or personal injury sustained whilst taking part in or travelling to and from this event.

Other useful information

Goodrich Park is located just outside of the village of Palgrave and access to the showground is from the A143. The nearby town of Diss has a range of shops and facilities.

Toilets will be available from Friday 16th June and drinking water is available on site.

Please go to a Steward with any questions you have whilst on site.

The postcode for the showground is IP22 1BA, however entrance to showground will be signposted off the A143 (Old Bury Road) Should you require an ambulance overnight, then please quote this postcode and inform security at the Entrance Gate.
